Long Island Caddie Scholarship Fund

Founded in 1962, the Long Island Caddie Scholarship Fund provides need-based financial assistance to college students who are caddies or have otherwise worked in service to golf.

Since inception, the LICSF has awarded 725 scholarships, totaling about \$3.85 million. In 2016 we again had 36 new recipients. For the 2016-2017 academic year we are helping 113 scholars who are attending colleges ranging from Nassau and Suffolk Community Colleges to Harvard University. We are pleased to help support the educational advancement of this outstanding group of young men and women.

Meadow Brook Club

The Meadow Brook Hunt Club was incorporated in Westbury in May 1881. The Club included the famous Meadow Brook Hounds. Future President Theodore Roosevelt was a member and hosted a meeting at his home in Oyster Bay in 1886. The Hunt Club gave birth to the Meadowbrook Polo Club which had 8 polo fields in Westbury and became the leading polo center in the US hosting many national and international events up until World War II.

The original golf course was built in 1894 and was a nine-hole course. The club became the 37th member of the USGA and in 1897 became a charter member of the MGA. When the Meadow Parkway was built, the Club relocated to Jericho and broke ground on a new, Dick Wilson designed course in 1953. The new course was opened for play in 1955 to much acclaim. Legendary golf writer Herbert Warren Wind, writing in Sports Illustrated called it: "...the finest golf course that has been built in this country since Bob Jones and Dr. Alister MacKenzie produced Augusta National back in 1931."

In 2016, architect Brian Silva began work on a modernization of Meadow Brook that includes 7 new tees, complete renovation of the bunkers and the softening of some of the dog legs. The course closed last August to allow the work to be completed all at once and it reopened in April.
