Our Mission

The Long Island Caddie Scholarship Fund (LICSF) provides need based financial assistance to deserving caddies and others who have worked in service to golf, assisting in the pursuit of a higher education.

Our History

The LICSF was founded in 1962 by George Sands, a long-time member of North Shore CC and dedicated volunteer for the LICSF, MGA and USGA. . Since then the LICSF has awarded over 690 scholarships totaling more than \$3.6 million. In 2015 we had our largest new class: 36 scholars. This brought the total number of students on scholarship for the 2015-2016 academic year to exactly 100.

Scholarships

LICSF Scholarships were increased to \$2,500 for new recipients in 2015. Awards cover up to 4 years of undergraduate study or for study at an accredited trade school. After the initial award, students submit annual transcripts and class schedules showing that they are continuing their education and renewal checks are issued.

Eligibility

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have been accepted at or currently attend an accredited school, and have two years experience as a caddie or other role in service to golf. The applicant must be recommended by a representative of the member club where they work.

Funding

The LICSF is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. Individual members and member golf clubs make donations to support the LICSF. The LICSF also conducts two annual fund raising events: a golf tournament and a Golf Marathon.
